"Discover Historic Richmond" Scavenger Hunt of Capitol Square**

Directions for Scavenger Hunt of Capitol Square:

1. State Capitol

** Start here and then walk over to the Governor's Mansion*

2. Governor's Mansion

** When you leave the Governor's Mansion take a right down the brick walk and through the cast iron fence.*

3. Morson's Row

** Across Governor's Street you will see Morson's Row, a row three connected town houses*

4. Old State Library

** Turn around and you will see the Old State Library, located at the corner of*

5. Old City Hall

** Old City Hall is located to the West of the Old State Library, turn and walk down the brick connecting path to the Washington Monument*

6. St. Paul's Church

** Walk down 9th Street and walk up the connecting brick path through the cast iron fence to the Bell Tower*

7. Bell Tower

** Walk the brick pathway until you reach the stairs that open on to Bank Street. View the U.S. Customs House across the street.*

8. U. S. Customs House

** The front of the building is located on the other side of the building at 1000 Main Street. You are now done!*

By the end of this tour you will have identified 7 different styles of architecture as well as important lessons in early Richmond history.
